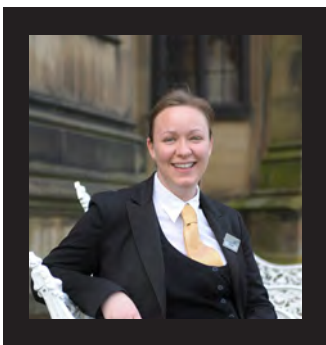


Dine Hospitality

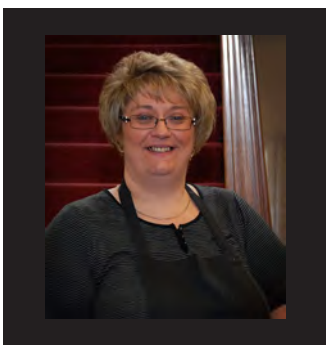

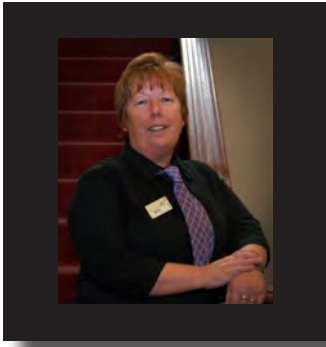
Liz Wood, Kitchen Manager

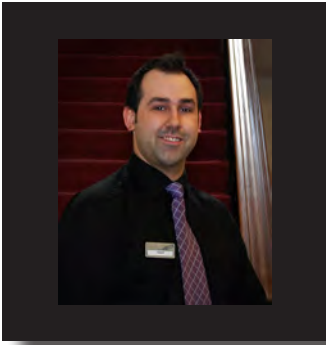
Glenda Riggon, Catering Assistant
